The Gospel Hill Lighthouse

What began as a vision from God is now a real Lighthouse standing on a hill in East Central Ohio.

In the past twelve years a few thousand people, from forty-one states and nineteen foreign countries, have visited this unique structure, unique in that it sits on a hill in Ohio, and not along a sea, lake or even a river. The closest water is about one mile away, the Killbuck Creek, unique in that it really shines out a light (an old airport light) can be seen for miles away.

However, the most important aspect of the Gospel Hill Lighthouse is that it represents a person. A person who brings light into people's lives when they are living in darkness of sin. It represents One who can guide people who are in deep despair in their walk of life. It represents the person of God, Jesus, who said "I am the Light of the world, he who follows me shall not walk in darkness but have the Light of life."

When I was given the vision of a light-house, back in 1976, the Lord also spoke to me saying "Go to Gospel Hill and build this lighthouse. It will do three things, it will draw people to Gospel Hill; it will be a prayer tower and you will be able to tell everyone that Jesus is the real lighthouse in the world."

In 2002 ground was broken for the building of this lighthouse. In September of 2003, it was finished and dedicated to God, to begin fulfilling what I had seen and heard from the Lord.

The light shines out into the darkness each night. Daily prayers are lifted in the prayer room and everyone who visits is told that Jesus is the real Lighthouse.


You are invited to come and visit the Gospel Hill Lighthouse, located three miles north off of U.S. Rt. 36 between Coshocton



Our Trip to San Carlos

Our recent mission trip and work at San Carlos, Arizona, on the San Carlos Apache Indian Reservation, was very successful in many ways.

I was a part of a small, four men, mission team who traveled to San Carlos to minister and do some work on the San Carlos Miracle Church. As for the physical work we had planned to perform was to leave a portion of the floor, patch the roof and evaluate with plans to replace it soon.

Well, the Lord had some things different in mind. Arriving late in the afternoon, we drove from Globe to see if anyone was at the church. As we walked in two of the men of the church were up on a ladder trying to fix the lights, which were not adequate and outdated (ballasts and bulbs outdated). We also noticed that the floor and walls had been repaired.

So, the Lord changed out plans. However, as the Lord always does, He had the right people for the new work. Paul Reed, Roger Perdue and Rick Prosser are very talented in many construction work areas. mainly electrical. We got to work the next day and were able to rebuild and up date eighteen lights in the sanctuary and auditorium area. New updated ballasts and The roofs on three buildings were bulbs. fixed and will be good for another four to five years. Praise The Lord was our response!!! We followed His lead and accomplished more than we ever had expected to do.

We also had great response in the services and believe our visit to the Miracle Church was successful spiritually as well. The people of the church greeted us in love and the fellowship with them was so rewarding.

Back in 1994, when Gospel Hill decided to do mission work and ministry among the Native American Indians, our goal was to build a good and trustworthy relationship with them. This relationship had been broken so many times over the past 200 years. As Christians I've always felt we, white Americans, must do our best to bring unity and trust with our Indian brothers and sisters illustrating we are all one in Christ Jesus. I Corinthians 12:20

This past trip is evidence that God is working in that direction.

THANK YOU TO OUR MILITARY




he area in which I live and pastor we are blessed with a great group of veterans.

I can only speak for those veterans in the area I'm in, but on behalf many others I say "thank you."


