

Sunday morning services are open to everyone each Sunday at 10:30 AM.


We would love to have you with us. If you are passing through or live in the area you will be welcomed!

The Gospel Hill Lighthouse is shining a light into this dark world, both physically and spiritually.



An old airport light is located in the top of the Lighthouse and shines all night long. It's beam is seen for miles, flashing over the valley below & on the hills in the distance.

The Gospel Hill Lighthouse has stood at Gospel Hill for over fourteen years shining a light which represents "Jesus" who is the Light of the World. John 8:12

Spiritually it is a light, as it serves as a place of prayer. It also welcomes people to visit as they go up to the observation area and view God's creation.

Thousands of people have visited from 45 states and 23 foreign countries in these past years.

Located on top of a hill, about 3 miles north off of U.S. Rt. 36 between Coshocton and Warsaw, Coshocton County, Ohio

The Lighthouse is open 9 AM—3 PM Monday through Friday and by appointment evenings & weekends.

PRAYER TOWER

When the Lord gave me the vision of the Gospel Hill Lighthouse, part of what He spoke to me, was that it would be a "Prayer Tower". A place where prayer would be lifted from the prayer requests we receive to a room for people to come and pray. This was fulfilled once the Lighthouse was built.

The second level of The Lighthouse (seen here) is where prayer meetings are held Monday through Friday. It is open for people to come and pray, read the Word of God or just meditate in His presence.



The Lighthouse prayer level is available for church groups to come, hold meetings or prayer vigils. Just call the Gospel Hill office at 740-824-3300 to reserve a time. Intercessory prayer has always been an important part of the Gospel Hill Ministry and we want to share this "place of prayer" with others.


